- 4) Is it never being "Mad", "Concerned", "Being Without Fear"? "No", "Not necessarily", Although, I believe that once you are fully walking in the "Blessings of God" you have the ability to live above the circumstances of this world.
- 5) Is it never feeling "Condemned", "Guilty", "Down"? "No", "Not necessarily", Although, I believe that once you are walking in the "Blessings of God" you have the ability to live above the circumstances of this world.
- 6) Is it never being, feeling, "????????" (You put here what you want), "No", "Not necessarily", Although, I believe that once you are fully walking in the "Blessings of God" you have the ability to live above the circumstances of this world.

I used to hate when people pointed at the things I did, the things I said, and me in "General" and say to me: "How can you be a Christian?" Let me give you some examples and see if you can relate:

- 1. I am a very competitive athlete and sometimes I would get "Mad" while competing.
- 2. When I would get frustrated with a situation it would make be get "Angry".
- 3. I enjoy a drink now and then. Usually beer but from time to time wine or a mixed drink.
- 4. I go to the gym where there are lots of pretty girls and sometimes I would look at one for longer then I should and even have a lustful thought.
- 5. Sometimes I would be somewhere and actually look at a person and I would judge them for what they were doing, how they were dressed.
- 6. Sometimes someone would say or do something to me and I would get offended and react less then positively. Let's say at those moments he Christ in me did not always shine.

What I want to mention here is that "Satan - Condemns" and "God - Convicts". Until I realized the difference I was always living a life of defeat because I felt unworthy. We will bet more into this later but for now remember what the word of God say in John 3:17:
